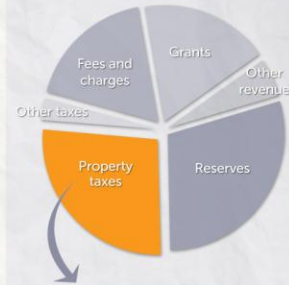

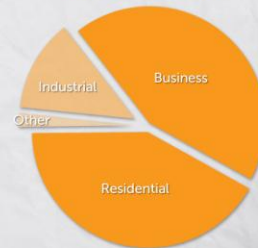

ABOUT THIS GRAPHIC:

Numbers in this infographic represent the best estimates currently available, and are provided for the purpose of comparison only. Capital costs have been annualized based on amortization, noted in brackets. Average homeowner costs based on average 2013 property value of \$236,000. Equivalent property taxes are intended to communicate the relative scale of costs/savings; actual property taxes may or may not change based on the options shown. MMBC is MultiMaterials BC, the agency responsible for stewardship of paper and printed packaging.

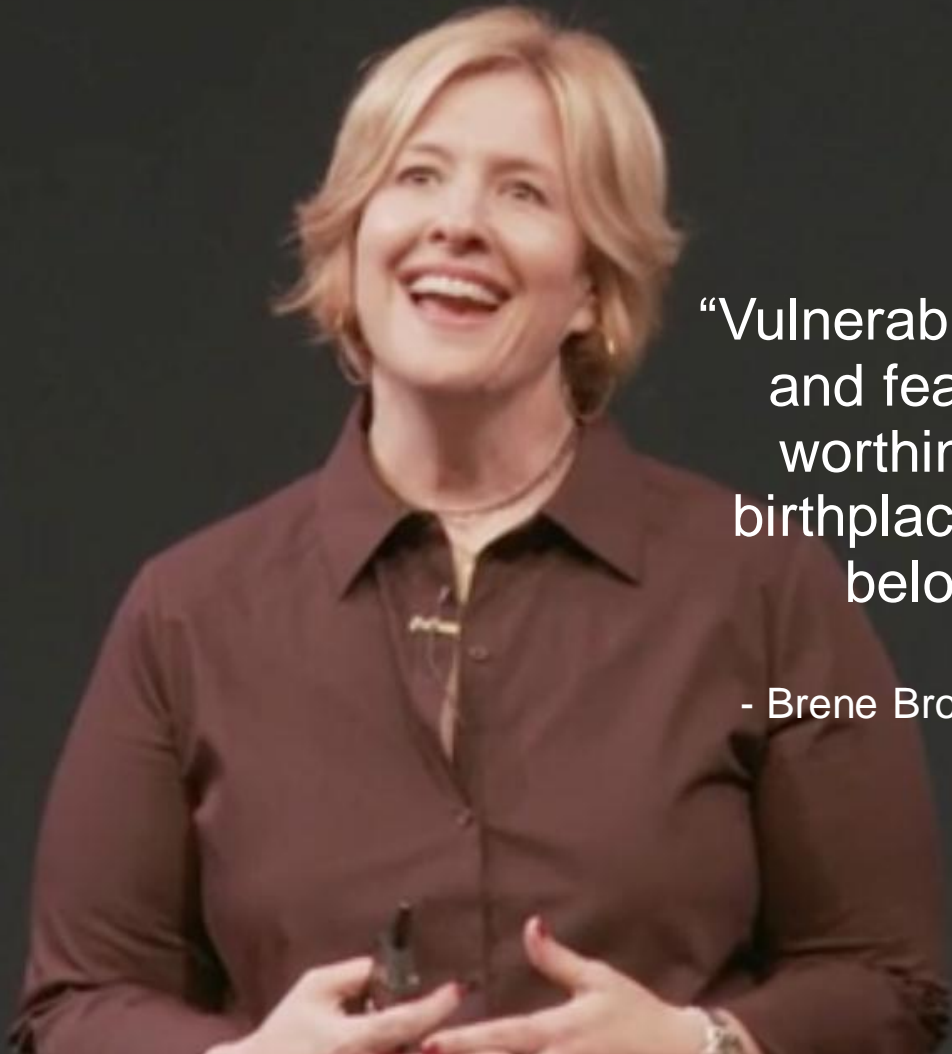
