- The renewed program will deliver \$1.3 billion over the first five years of the agreement



New Eligible Categories Local and Regional Airports • Airport related infrastructure such as runways, taxiways, terminal buildings, and groundside access Short-sea Shipping • Infrastructure related to the movement of cargo and passengers around the coast and on inland waterways. Short-line Rail • Railway related infrastructure for carriage of passengers or freight

New Eligible Categories	
Sport Infrastructure	
Sport infrastructure for community public use or in support of major amateur athletic events	
Tourism Infrastructure	
 Infrastructure that attract travelers for recreation, leisure or business such as convention centres, exhibition halls and visitor centres 	
Cultural Infrastructure	
 Supports arts, humanities and heritage such as museums, libraries, and the preservation of designated heritage sites. 	


New Eligible Categories Brownfield Redevelopment • Remediation or decontamination and redevelopment of a brownfield site within local government boundaries where the redevelopment includes the construction of public infrastructure as identified in the other categories Broadband Connectivity • Infrastructure that provides internet access to residents, businesses, and or institutions in BC

UBCM New Eligible Categories Recreation Infrastructure

- Facilities or complexes which support physical activity such as arenas, pools, sports fields
- Community Centres that offer programming to the community at large
 Networks of parks, fitness trails and bike paths


Disaster Mitigation


- Infrastructure that reduces or eliminates long-term impacts and risks associated with natural disasters
- Category is related to disaster prevention such as dykes, berms, seismic upgrades etc
- Not related to disaster response such as fire trucks and fire halls



Stream-lined Program Delivery

- 3 Program areas
 - Community Works Fund
 - Includes \$50,000 funding floor
 - Strategic Priorities Fund
 - Greater Vancouver Regional Fund

Community Works Fund

- Direct allocation to all Local Governments
- Delivered twice annually
- Allocation based on a per-capita formula plus a funding floor
- Local Governments make local decisions on which eligible projects to fund with CWF

Greater Vancouver Regional Fund



UBCM

Greater Vancouver Regional Fund

- Pooled funding program for projects within the Greater Vancouver Regional District
- Projects are submitted by TransLink and approved by the GVRD Board
- Must be identified as transportation related projects



UBCM

Strategic Priorities Fund

- Application based funding program for local governments outside the GVRD
- Supports investments in infrastructure that are <u>large</u> in scale or <u>regional in impact</u> or <u>innovative</u>
- UBCM is currently accepting applications through an online submission at ubcm.ca
- Intake closes on April 15, 2015

 - Before April 1, 2014 old Agreement requirements
 - After April 1, 2014 renewed Agreement Requirements

Interest

- Approximately \$8 million in interest is available from the first GTA Agreement
- Interest will be delivered over the next 2 years
- Interest will be delivered through funding programs of the renewed Agreement

- o Next intake (funding permitting) Fall 2015

- Strategic Wildfire Prevention Initiative
 - Supporting communities to mitigate risk from wildfire in the wildland urban interface by identifying and taking steps to reduce forest fuels.
 - o Launched in 2004
 - Four program streams: Community Wildfire Protection Plans, Fuel Management Prescriptions, Demonstration Projects, Operational Treatments
 - o Next intake (for CWPPs only) January 30, 2015

New Building Canada Fund – Small Communities Fund

- Approximately \$109 million (federal)
 \$327 (3/3rds) Total Project Funding
- 10 year program (2014 2024)
- Communities less than 100,000 population
- First intake closes February 18, 2015
 - Up to 50% of program funds will be allocated

New Building Canada Fund – Small Communities Fund

- Eligible Applicants
 - Local Governments
 - First Nations
 - Provincial entity or public sector body
 - Private sector body
- Eligible applicants may submit <u>one</u> application per intake

UBCM

New Building Canada Fund – Small Communities Fund

- Eligible Project Categories
 - Similar to Gas Tax no recreation, sport, tourism, culture or capacity building
- Stacking Rules
 - Reduced from 50% to 33% federal contribution
- UBCM Role

- Administered by the Province
 - Ministry of Community, Sport and Cultural Development
 - Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure
