- The largest class-action settlement in Canadian history = the Federal Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement
- The Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada (TRC) was born to:
  - historical reporting on residential schools,
     gather statements from survivors,
- fund and host events across Canada, Reconciliation Canada revitalize the relationships between Aboriginal peoples and all Canadians to uphold and advance the TRC
   Community Engagement Workshop in Alberni Valley on May 15, 2013

  - Requests local governments of Alberni Clayoquot Regional District to declare 2013 as the year of Reconciliation and take further actions to inform themselves and their constituents about reconciliation and the impact of IRS.

The Board of Directors unanimously committed to adopt practices and take meaningful actions of respect to help break the cycle of hurt and suffering.




## Actions to consider based on the ACRD Experience.


- Through a planning strategy consider your governments role.

   Find proportunities to share resources training utilities facilities.




