Delegates Explore "Respectful Leadership" at 2016 LGLA Leadership Forum

Delegates attending the 2016 LGLA Leadership Forum enjoyed an excellent line-up of speakers and presenters at one of the highest-rated LGLA events to date. The Forum began with Dr. Bev Busson, former RCMP Commissioner, delivering a keynote address on the topic of 3-Dimensional Leadership. Up next was a session on Community Engagement led by the SFU Civic Engage team, followed by some time to relax and connect with colleagues old and new at the annual LGLA Welcome Reception. The next day of the forum featured a partnership between LGLA and the Local Government Management Association to offer a session on Elected-Elected-Staff Relations and Conflict Engagement and Communication. Also on the agenda were sessions on Self Leadership, Managing Work-Life Balance, Effective Meetings and Encounters with the Public, and Reconciliation for Local Governments and First Nations. Dr. Gordon McIntosh brought the whole crowd back on our jam-packed second day for an evening session on civility and understanding the impact your personality has on those around you. Early morning clinics were offered by the Union of BC Municipalities, Municipal Insurance Association and BC Assessment. And our final day included sessions brought to our delegates by the Office of the Ombudsperson, the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner, Reconciliation Canada and local law firms Harris & Co. and Young Anderson, The Honourable Peter Fassbender, Minister of Community, Sport and Cultural Development brought greetings from the province, and Forum Rapporteur Ken Cameron provided some perspective on the overall proceedings in our closing session.

Forum Evaluation
