













Transport Canada Protective Direction 36

- Canada's railways worked with Transport Canada and FCM to develop Pratective Direction 36. Under PD 36, CN provides registered municipalities with:

 Reports on the Dangerous goods that move through a community

 A standardized format for presenting data through CAMUTEC

 Public version of the PD 36 report that can be shared with community
- Dangerous goods data provided to communities includes:

 Information on the number of unit trains

 Percentage of railway cars transporting dangerous goods

 Information on the nature and volume

- CN posts on its Web site information about DG movements broken down by province, updated annually
