Protective Direction 36



- Canada's railways worked with Transport Canada and FCM to develop *Protective Direction 36*. Under PD 36, CN provides registered municipalities with:
 - Reports on the Dangerous goods that move through a community
 - A standardized format for presenting data through CANUTEC
 - Public version of the PD 36 report that can be shared with community
- Dangerous goods data provided to communities includes:
 - Information on the number of unit trains
 - Percentage of railway cars transporting dangerous goods
 - Information on the nature and volume
- CN posts on its Web site information about DG movements broken down by province, updated annually
